Dais Analytic strikes deal with University of Florida

Dais Analytic Corp. expects to move a key product closer to commercialization after signing a research agreement with **University of Florida**.

The agreement focuses on Dais' NanoCap ultracapacitor, an energy storage device, a press statement said. Financial terms of the deal with UF were not disclosed.

A device such as NanoCap would allow electricity from intermittent electricity generators, such as solar panels and wind turbines, to be stored for use at a later time.

GE's Global Research and Development Center has tested Dais' materials and design, and results showed great promise to yield a power storage device able to dramatically improve power delivery from consumer electronics to "smart grid" applications to most forms of transportation, the statement said.

Testing to date shows the materials have the potential of being configured into an energy storage unit capable of replacing the internal combustion engine, Scott Ehrenberg, Dais' chief technology officer, said in the statement.

Dais will work with a University of Florida team headed by Saeed Moghaddam, Tim Tangredi, president of Dais, said. Moghaddam is an assistant professor in mechanical and aerospace engineering.

Dais (OTCBB: DLYT) is a nanotechnology company headquartered in Odessa.
